SPECIAL SESSION

I. CALL TO ORDER AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:

1. Public hearing on CDBG Grant Application

Administrator Bennett read the entire public notice that was published in the News Review into the record. The City can qualify for up to \$2.5 million in grant funding for the upgrade to the City’s water system. The City will be submitting a grant application of \$400,00.00 for the engineering design, administrative costs and environmental review for the project. Once the design is completed the city will apply for the project construction.

*Mayor Morgan asked if there was anyone who wished to testify in support or opposition to the project.

There was no public present at the meeting and no comments were submitted to the City prior to the meeting.

*Mayor Morgan closed the public hearing.

Mayor Morgan asked why the 2” galvanized pipe on NW Carlisle was being replaced with 2” pvc pipe instead of the 6” pvc. Planner Evans responded that it was a good question and she would ask the engineer.

Councilor O’Sullivan moved, and Councilor Barton seconded a motion to approve the submittal of the Community Development Block Grant Mayor Morgan, Councilors Barton, Freeman, O’Sullivan, Morgan, and Suhr voted “yes.” No “nays.” The motion carried.


IV. ADJOURNMENT
